

Collection HS-4: U. Miami Non-Undergraduate Survey (major / minor data)

A collection of UM survey responses from 236 non-undergraduate participants. Respondents answered 66 questions, including multiple choice and discursive responses. However, none of the respondents answered the totality of the questions. Non-undergraduate

respondents are grouped into graduate students (66%) and other non-undergraduates (31%). Respondents who identify in both have been counted twice. The remaining 18% did not specify their UM affiliation.
