PURPOSE OF STUDY:

This survey is part of the WhatEvery1Says research project. We are asking you to take part in our study because we are trying to learn more about what people think about the humanities. A key ambition of our project is to understand how different communities relate to and speak about the humanities, with the ultimate goal of crafting advocacy materials informed by such research. You are being asked to participate in a survey, which consists mainly of questions about your educational experiences and perspectives, particularly in relation to the humanities. There are no foreseeable risks to this study. You will also not benefit directly from it, nor will you receive compensation. You must be 18 or older to participate. We estimate this survey will take approximately 10-15 minutes to complete.

You may choose whether to provide your name and contact information for the purposes of entering a raffle or following up with the project to participate in a focus group. In any public outputs of the project, your real name and contact information will not be attached to any of the answers that you provide to written survey questions.

Your responses and comments may be used or quoted for research and teaching purposes by the WhatEvery1Says Team or by individual project members, including, but not limited to, presentations, publications (such as blog posts, journal articles, and books), and advocacy and pedagogical materials. Your data and responses may be transcribed and added to our existing corpus of materials, to be analyzed through digital methods. Your responses may also be shared with project collaborators beyond UM.

All participants who choose to provide their names and contact information at the end of the survey will be entered in a raffle to win one of ten gift cards (\$25 value). However, all of your answers will be coded by an identifying number rather than your name, and your name will not be attached to your responses in any way. Only people who are directly involved with the project will have access to these records. When the project is finished and results are reported, no individual will be identified in any way.

Your participation is voluntary. You can decline to participate, and you can stop your participation at any time, if you wish to do so, without any negative consequences to you.
